SCHOLARSHIP: A \$500 one-time, non-renewable scholarship.

ELIGIBILITY:

You are eligible to apply if you are a graduating high school student from El Dorado Union High School District (El Dorado, Independence, Mountain View, Shenandoah, Vista, Ponderosa, Union Mine, Oak Ridge High Schools and EDUSHD Community Day School) and enrolling in a university, college or vocational school this fall or winter.

Instructions

1. Applicant must be pursuing a career in textiles, fiber arts or art fields in their advanced education.
2. Applicant must have a cumulative GPA of 3.0.
3. Submit a written 500 word essay on the subject of *"Who or what inspired you to pursue a career in art"*.
4. Applicant must attach a current transcript and a letter of recommendation from a teacher, minister, employer or community leader.
5. If chosen as a finalist, the applicant must be prepared to give a 10-minute presentation to Gold Bug Quilters outlining your accomplishments, hopes, aspirations, and goals in your chosen field.

Your application, current transcript, letter of recommendation and essay must be received by March 1ST.
