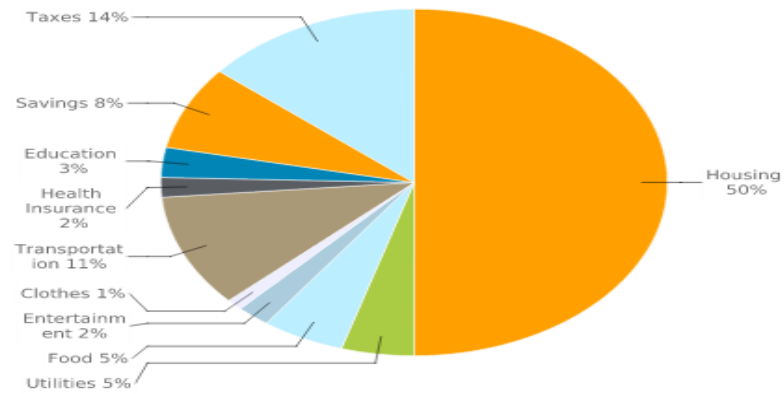

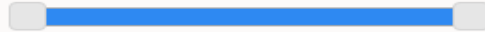

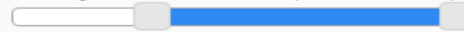
## Occupations that Meet Your Budget
