UNIVERSITY OF THE PACIFIC - SANDY PRICE MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP

The Sandy Price Endowed Memorial Scholarship was established in 1953 by the Caldor Lumber Co. This scholarship is in memory of the sterling character of Lieutenant Sanford L. (Sandy) Price and in appreciation of his patriotic devotion to the highest ideals of young American manhood. This academic meritorious and good citizen scholarship will be awarded to an EDHS student graduating with the EDHS Class of 2019, to enter University of the Pacific in fall of 2019.

Criteria for the scholarship are as follows:

- A graduating senior male student (*If none qualify, the award will go to a female student.* Female students should apply as well.)
- Demonstrate good citizenship
- Financial need as determined by the FAFSA and verified by University of the Pacific's Financial Aid Office
- Carry a 3.0 or higher GPA

Applicant must be Roman Catholic, have a minimum 3.2 GPA, and be a resident of California, Nevada, Arizona, or an Illinois city where branches of the Federation are established. Applicant must be wholly or partially of Italian ancestry or be the child or grandchild of an ICF member.
