

EL DORADO HIGH SCHOOL TARDY POLICY

Students are expected to be in class and in their assigned seats when the tardy bell rings. Teachers will enforce tardy policies within their classrooms.

VIOLATIONS PER QUARTER

- 3 tardies in one class period will result in teacher consequence.
- 6 tardies in one class period will result in 1 Saturday school.
- 9 tardies in one class period will result in 2 Saturday schools.

Students accumulating 12 or more cumulative tardies within a Quarter will be referred to an Assistant Principal and will be placed on Social Probation. Continued tardiness will result in progressive discipline for defiance and may be referred to SARB (Student Attendance Review Board). Students and parents may access attendance records by logging onto their Aeries accounts.

For the first class of the day students are expected to be in class and in their assigned seat when the tardy bell rings. If students are not in their seats the following consequences occur:

CONSEQUENCES

- Students who are tardy within 10 minutes of the tardy bell ringing should report directly to class and will receive a tardy. They should NOT report to the office.
- Students who are over 10 minutes late should report to the main office to check in and will receive 1 detention up to 30 minutes late.
- Students who are over 30 minutes late will result in an unexcused absence for the period and will receive 2 detentions.
