

## **AVAILABLE POSTIONS ON THE YEARBOOK STAFF**

#### PHOTOGRAPHER

They also upload, sort, and edit photos, write photo captions and conduct interviews.

Reporters conduct the bulk of our interviews and therefore determine the content of our book—they basically choose the stories we write. They may also write and photograph.

They apply our design style and create pages that deliver our content in a way that is innovative and contemporary, yet still readable.


#### WRITER (LITERARY STAFF)

### **EDITOR (\*LEADERSHIP POSITION)**


